X & XII Results 2020-2021

As the spread of COVID 19 was in peak, the CBSE was not in a position to conduct Board examination for the year 2020-2021. Hence, CBSE has suggested some guidelines to award marks to the students of class X and XII.

Class XII:

40% marks secured in the Pre-board /Mid term , 30% marks from their class XI Final examination and 30% based on their Internal Assessment and Practicals. Our school has been provided 2019 as Reference year by CBSE to award marks to the students

- As per the CBSE guidelines, The “Result committee” of X std was set up. It comprises the School Principal, five senior teachers of the school and Two External Examiners from Thiruthangal Nadar Vidyalaya, Thiruvottriyur and Kavi Bharati vidyalaya, Thiruvottriyur.
- XII std “Result committee” consists of the School Principal, two senior teachers of the school and Two External Examiners from RMK Patashala, Kavaraipettai and Jain Vidyashram, Puzhal.

Annual examination for LKG to IX & XI std commenced from March, 2021.

Online classes for the academic year 2021-2022 commenced in the month of April through Google meet.

As per the instructions of Tamilnadu Government, we began the Regular classes for IX to XII Std on 01.09.2021.

CBSE has changed the Pattern of Examinations into two terms due to the existing pandemic situation. We feel immensely happy to express that our vidyalaya was allotted as centre for the conduction of CBSE Term 1 Board Examination. The X std students of Sri Sathya Sai Vihar, Thiruvottriyur appeared for their board examination in our school from 18.11.2021 to 11.12.2021 .

As per the CBSE guidelines, the Board examination answer scripts were evaluated by our team of teachers under the supervision of the Observers Smt. Sai Sindhuja Rachamala, Principal of Narayana E-Techno school, Mint , Shri. Chalapathy, PGT Narayana E-techno school, ponniamman nagar , Smt.R. Nalini, PGT, Maths SRDK Vivekananda Vidyalaya, TVT and Shri. Gowtham , PGT Surana Jain vidyalaya.

Our teachers met the parents of LKG to XII std through online/ offline. Many parents have given their valuable suggestions and extended their support in our school endeavors.

We regularly conduct Spoken English through PPT, Grammar classes , Sanskrit classes and Geetha chanting sessions for the teachers. We equip our teachers with computer knowledge and improve their technical skill.

To bring out the holistic development, Vivekananda Educational Society facilitated multiple pathway to enable every teacher to develop their maximum potential, innovative teaching and spirituality. An academic enrichment programme was organized in the month of May, 2021 for the duration of fifteen days. Shri.U.Sakthivel, M.Sc.,. B.Ed.,. Dept. of Science has hosted a session in the Enrichment programme on the topic “My Locality” of class III. Apart from this, emphasize was also given on “Gunathmic” too. Quiz competition was conducted by the teachers at the end of the programme. Questions related to the activities were posed to the students and winners of the quiz were felicitated with prizes.

CBSE planned for “Rashtriya Poshan Maah” programme in schools. Students of our vidyalaya were insisted on this noble cause and necessary awareness were created by conducting activities like speech, observation of nutrition week, etc.,. Our Principal addressed the gathering and delivered the speech on the significance of being protected from these cyber crimes.

❖ **Spiritual development :**

To inculcate Spitritual Development in the young minds, Mass Chanting of Vishnu Sahasranamam was conducted in a holistic manner virtually. All the teachers and few students have took part in the mass chanting.

Vishnu Sahasranamam chanting is performed by the teachers every Saturday.

We celebrated number of cultural festivals like Aksharabhyas, Gurupoornima , Thiruvillakku pooja, Raksha Bandhan, Krishna Jayanthi, Vinayagar Chathurthi, Navarathri, Kandha Shasti, Karthigai Deepam, Marghazhi Mahotsav, Vasantha Panchami and Ratha Sapthami to develop Spiritualism in our students.

Aksharabhyasam - a traditional religious occasion gives initiation to a child to receive formal education. Such an auspicious celebration was performed for our LKG tiny kids on Vijayadasami day - 15.10.2021. Shri.Nagarajan jee, SMDC member was present for the occasion.

❖ **Vasantha Panchami celebration:**

A day dedicated to Goddess Saraswati, who is believed to confer knowledge, music and arts, Vasant Panchami or Saraswati Puja was celebrated in our vidyalaya on 05.02.2022 – Saturday. Our staff Shri. B. **Kanirajan** has explained the importance of observing this day to help the needy people .Selvi B. Kanishka of X std has given a detailed speech about this great day. Our students and teachers have contributed Rs. 13,648/- towards the education of destitutes during the Vasantha Panchami celebration.

❖ **Geetha Day celebration:**

This day was celebrated on 14.12.2021 (Tuesday). The school choir team presented a feast through Bhajan songs. The students of VI to VIII std have recited the 18 "Asthatasa Sloki Geetha" with spiritual fervour. Smt. V. P.
